and children ages 5 to 10 will participate as a second group.

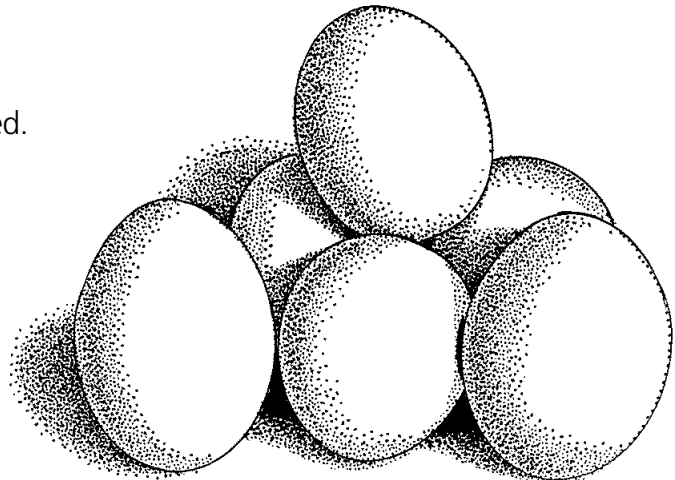
**Why:** **Fun for the whole family!** Remember to bring your baskets.
