The Two Plus One Plus One Program

Spartanburg Technical College University of South Carolina Upstate Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic

This agreement is designed to facilitate student transfer from Spartanburg Technical College to the University of South Carolina Upstate to Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic for students desiring Bachelor of Arts (BA) Degree/Bachelor of Science (BS) Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies (IDS) and Doctor of Chiropractic (DC) degrees.

Admissions Information

Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic will guarantee admission to students from Spartanburg Technical College and from University of South Carolina Upstate who meet the following provisions:

1. Students must have successfully completed the prescribed curriculum of the Two Plus One Plus One Agreement and must have satisfied residency and general education requirements at USC Upstate.
2. No grade below "C" will be accepted for transfer to USC Upstate. No grade below "C" in core courses will be accepted for transfer to Sherman.
3. Students must have earned a minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average and a minimum 2.50 grade point average in the core courses required for admission to Sherman College.
4. Students will be granted tentative acceptance upon completion of a minimum 45 semester hours with final acceptance granted upon receipt of the student's final transcript from USC Upstate.

5. Students who successfully complete all courses in the first four quarters at Sherman College will be granted the BA/BS Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from USC Upstate.

Transfer Requirements

In a Two Plus One Plus One Program, a student earns the Associate of Science Degree with a focus on Pre-Chiropractic from Spartanburg Technical College and the BA or a BS Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from USC Upstate.

Students transferring to USC Upstate with the Associate of Science Degree from STC will complete a minimum of 30 hours in the interdisciplinary studies core, which must include the remaining core requirements for admission to Sherman College. Those students may transfer to Sherman College and will receive a BA/BS Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from USC Upstate after successful completion of all courses in the first four quarters.

There are a number of interdisciplinary studies options from which to choose:

- an upper-level science track
- a business track
- a communications track

Upon successful completion of all courses at Sherman College, students will receive a Doctor of Chiropractic (DC) degree.
