



DRESS AND GROOM STANDARDS

POLICY

This policy pertains to classroom dress. The required dress code for Health Center Interns is found in the Student Intern Handbook.

Personal hygiene should be practiced at all times.

Dress should be neat and clean, and within the following guidelines:

- 1) Tattered, threadbare or dirty articles of clothing are not to be worn.
- 2) Footwear is to be worn at all times. Students enrolled in technique classes may be required by class instructors to wear appropriate footwear to perform leg checks.
- 3) Cut-offs are not allowed. Nicely styled warm-up suits are acceptable. Wearing apparel should be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- 4) Bare midriffs, men's sleeveless shirts or beachwear are not allowed. Also, women's spaghetti strap or camisole type shirts are not allowed unless a cover shirt is worn on top.
- 5) White T-shirts or other articles of clothing considered to be underwear, if worn, are to be worn as such under other articles of clothing. Thong underwear needs to be concealed by clothing.
- 6) Hair is to be clean and neatly groomed.
- 7) Beards and mustaches are permitted if neatly groomed and trimmed.
