POLICY

Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic will publish, on at least a biennial basis, the Bulletin of Sherman College of Straight Chiropractic in which public disclosure will be made on the items of importance to prospective and current students, and the general public.

Disclosure will include, but is not limited to, the following areas:

- A. A description of the institution's mission, goals and program objectives.
- B. A list of the members of the institution's governing board, the chief administrative officer, and administrative officers.
- C. A list of the members of the faculty with their respective academic credentials.
- D. A list of courses offered, set forth by organizational units, and indication for each courses contents and value in terms of contact and/or credit hours.
- E. A description of entrance requirements.
- F. A description of graduation requirements.
- G. Policies and procedures regarding discipline, attendance, examinations, grades, satisfactory academic progress, and procedures for handling student complaints.
- H. A list of fees.
