



## COURSE OVERLOAD

---

### **POLICY**

A student may be permitted to take a course overload under these specific circumstances:

1. The student has a minimum GPA of 3.0.
2. The course does not conflict with other courses in the student's schedule.
3. The overload will not exceed 60 hours. (Clinic hours will be considered on an individual basis.)

Additionally, the student must meet one or more of the following conditions:

1. The overload is necessary in order to be able to schedule classes required to be eligible to take national boards. (NBCE eligibility would be delayed without a course overload.)
2. The overload would allow the student to return to a regular schedule within one or two quarters.
3. The student's graduation would be delayed without a course overload.

Registrar verification of graduation eligibility and clinic status is required.
