



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

POLICY

The college requires satisfactory completion of all courses for the doctor of chiropractic degree.

A minimum grade point average of 2.0 is required for graduation.

Before the college grants a degree, candidates for graduation must be cleared in the following areas:

1. All tuition, fees and other bills must be paid to the college business office.
2. The vice president for academic affairs must give clearance indicating that all academic requirements have been met.
3. All materials borrowed through the college library must be returned.

Note: In the event a student has cleared in all the above categories with the exception of financial clearance, he/she may be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony, but will not receive a diploma until financial obligations are met. Under no circumstances may a student participate in the ceremony without academic and clinical clearance.
