The courses that are in bold represent preferred classes for Sherman College.

Year One

- English I and English II
- Anatomy/Physiology I and II (with Lab)
- General Chemistry I and II (with Lab)
- College Algebra
- Psychology
- Computer Science
- Trigonometry
- One course from Social Sciences/Humanities

Year Two

- Physics I (with Lab)
- Physics II (with Lab)

 or Biomechanics
- Organic Chemistry I (with Lab)
- Organic Chemistry II (with Lab)

 or Biochemistry
- Four courses from Social Sciences/Humanities

Year Three

Fulfill your elective credits to bring the total amount to <u>at least 90 earned hours</u>. Sherman College recommends that the electives you choose include:
