



CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE

POLICY

A conditional acceptance can be awarded to applicants who have completed a minimum of 75 semester hours (113 quarter hours) and are in progress with the remaining prerequisites. Among the 75 semester hours, the applicant must have obtained a C or higher for all completed science courses.

To be eligible for full approval, all prerequisites must be satisfactorily completed with a grade of C or higher and all final official transcripts must be received.

To be eligible to register for first-quarter classes, a student must be fully approved or present an unofficial grade report or letter from the instructors for any prerequisites that are not reflected on an official transcript. A final official transcript must be received by the end of the first week of the matriculated quarter, or credit for first quarter will not be awarded and the student may not register for the second quarter.

The Admissions Committee may also consider applicants with identified risk factors for conditional admission. The committee will review all relevant information to determine eligibility. Students admitted conditionally will be provided with specific probationary requirements. Failure to meet these requirements will result in dismissal from the program without the option to appeal.
