

Tuition and Living Expense Estimates

Per Sherman College Policy Number 6012, three quarters (9 months) will constitute an academic year for financial programs. The program is 14 quarters in length. Your financial aid award letter will be built based on the current cost of attendance for your three-quarter package period and the financial aid for which you are eligible.

The cost of attendance (COA) includes direct costs, like tuition, in addition to other common costs associated with college enrollment, such as room and board, books/supplies, transportation and personal expenses.

Due to Sherman not having on-campus living accommodations or a meal plan option, all Room and Board totals are for off-campus living and non-institutionally owned food services.

*Tuition is the only cost billed to you by the Sherman Business Office.

*Tuition is based on 9 hours or greater. Less than 9 hours, \$1,164 per hour.

**Books/supplies for your first quarter can range from \$300-\$600.

A student with one or more dependents can request an allowance based on the estimated actual expenses incurred for such dependent care, based on the number and age of the dependents, except that-

- (A) such allowance shall not exceed the reasonable cost in the community in which such student resides for the kind of care provided; and
- (B) the period for which dependent care is required includes, but is not limited to, class-time, study-time, field work, internships, and commuting time
